An associate degree student who completes 4 Honors Program courses in 4 subject areas with a grade of A or B in each and has an overall grade point average of at least 3.5 is designated an Honors Program Graduate.

Program Requirements

- Take 4 Honors courses in 2 different disciplines (e.g., ENGL, POLS, PSYC, HIST, etc.)
- Complete each course with a grade of A or B
- Maintain an overall GPA of 3.5
