2. Term:

Terms of this Agreement will be effective October 1, 2016. Either party may terminate this agreement upon giving 60 days notice to the other party. Such notice must be given one full semester prior to the agreement being terminated.

3. Conditions:

Amendment to the Course Articulation Agreement

Computer Information Systems Degree

- The unit program will be open to all Fall Line Technical College students who have earned a Degree of Diploma from candidates entering the program from Middle Georgia State University, Great Smoky Mountains State University, Georgia State University, or Georgia State University, or from a Specialist in Web Site Design and Networking, Specialist in Information Technology, or a Specialist in Information Technology.
- Effective October 1, 2016, Middle Georgia State University, Georgia State University, and Georgia State University will be included in the articulation agreement between Middle Georgia State University, Georgia State University, and Georgia State University from institutions accredited by the Commission on Colleges.
- All Oconee Fall Line Technical College students who are currently enrolled in the program will be notified by email.
- Only Oconee Fall Line Technical College courses with a grade of C or higher will be transferred to apply toward the Bachelor of Science degree in Information Technology.
- Qualified Oconee Fall Line Technical College students may receive credit for up to 10 semester hours of level ITEC electives.

- Elective courses up to 10 semester hours of credit may be applied toward graduation in a course equivalency are established. Students interested in applying for credit should contact the Registrar's Office. Analysis of course equivalency will be conducted by faculty members of the Middle Georgia State University, Georgia State University, or Georgia State University. For each Computer Information Systems approved course, a course equivalency form will be provided. Students must provide a Middle Georgia State University, Georgia State University, or Georgia State University course catalog description and the course syllabus for each course.
- MGA credit will be calculated on all work attempted at MGA. This includes all work attempted at MGA in the major field and at least 20 semester hours of upper division courses in the major field.
- Of the 70 semester hours in the preceding paragraph, any student must complete at least 20 semester hours of upper division work.
- All University System of Georgia and Middle Georgia State University requirements for graduation must be satisfied.
- This agreement begins on October 1, 2016.
