MGED Academic Progress and Completion

Teacher candidates must meet the following requirements to remain in the MGED program:

1. Maintain an overall cumulative GPA of 2.75 or greater in all courses in the major. Students may be placed on probation within the School of Education during their junior year of the MGED program. 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7. Provide evidence of attempting GACE Content Exam prior to progression into MGED 4270.
8. Complete residency requirements for Middle Georgia State College.
9. Adhere to all policies and codes of personal and professional conduct which originate with the School of Education, Middle Georgia State College, the Georgia Professional Standards Commission and associated Boards of Education.

Candidates are recommended by the School of Education for certification after successful completion of the degree program and earning a passing score on the appropriate GACE content exam. Content exams area as follows:
