3.02.04.5 Standing Committees of the Senate

M. The Standing Committees of the Senate are as follows:

7. Promotion, Tenure, and Post-Tenure Review Universitywide Committee

a. Membership:

Only tenured faculty members at the minimum rank of Associate Professor are eligible to serve as representatives on the Promotion, Tenure, and Post-Tenure Review Committee. The Promotion & Tenure, and Post-Tenure Review Universitywide Committee shall consist of two full professors, three department chairs, and two associate professors that have successfully completed three years at this rank elected at large (see election below). Each member serves for two years.

b. Election:

Representatives of the Promotion, Tenure, and Post-Tenure Review Universitywide Committee shall be elected as needed from the Middle Georgia State University Academic Roster each spring. Although not the practice of the Senate, its Standing — one member at the rank of associate professor who has completed three years at this rank, and three members at the rank of full professor. In cases where the associate/ full professor/ department chair ratios change due to promotion or changes in status, the arrangement of two full professors, three department chairs, and two associate professors who have

Article VI. Standing Committees of the MGA Senate

- J. The Executive Committee, Academic Affairs Committee, Academic Personnel Policies Committee, Faculty Development Committee, Faculty Recognition Committee, Library Resources Committee, Technology Resources Committee, and Student Honors, Awards & Graduation Committee shall consist of faculty representatives indicated in these Bylaws, Article III B. The Student Affairs Committee and Campus Safety Committee shall consist of one faculty and one student representative from Cochran, Dublin, Eastman, Macon, and Warner Robins campuses. The In-campus Visiting Speakers committee shall consist of Deans of each School, three elected Senators, and the Vice President of Student Affairs; The Promotion, Tenure, and Post-Tenure Review Campuswide Committee shall consist of two full professors, three department chairs, and two associate professors who have completed three years at this rank. They shall be elected by the faculty of the Academic Assembly. (See committee composition descriptions below)

Article VI. Standing Committees of the MGA Senate

- J. The Executive Committee, Academic Affairs Committee, Academic Personnel Policies Committee, Faculty Development Committee, Faculty Recognition Committee, Library Resources Committee, Technology Resources Committee, and Student Honors, Awards & Graduation Committee shall consist of faculty representation as delineated in these Bylaws, Article III B. The Student Affairs Committee and Campus Safety Committee shall consist of one faculty and one student representative from Cochran, Dublin, Eastman, Macon, and Warner Robins campuses. The Intra-campus Visiting Speakers committee shall consist of Deans of each School, three
