



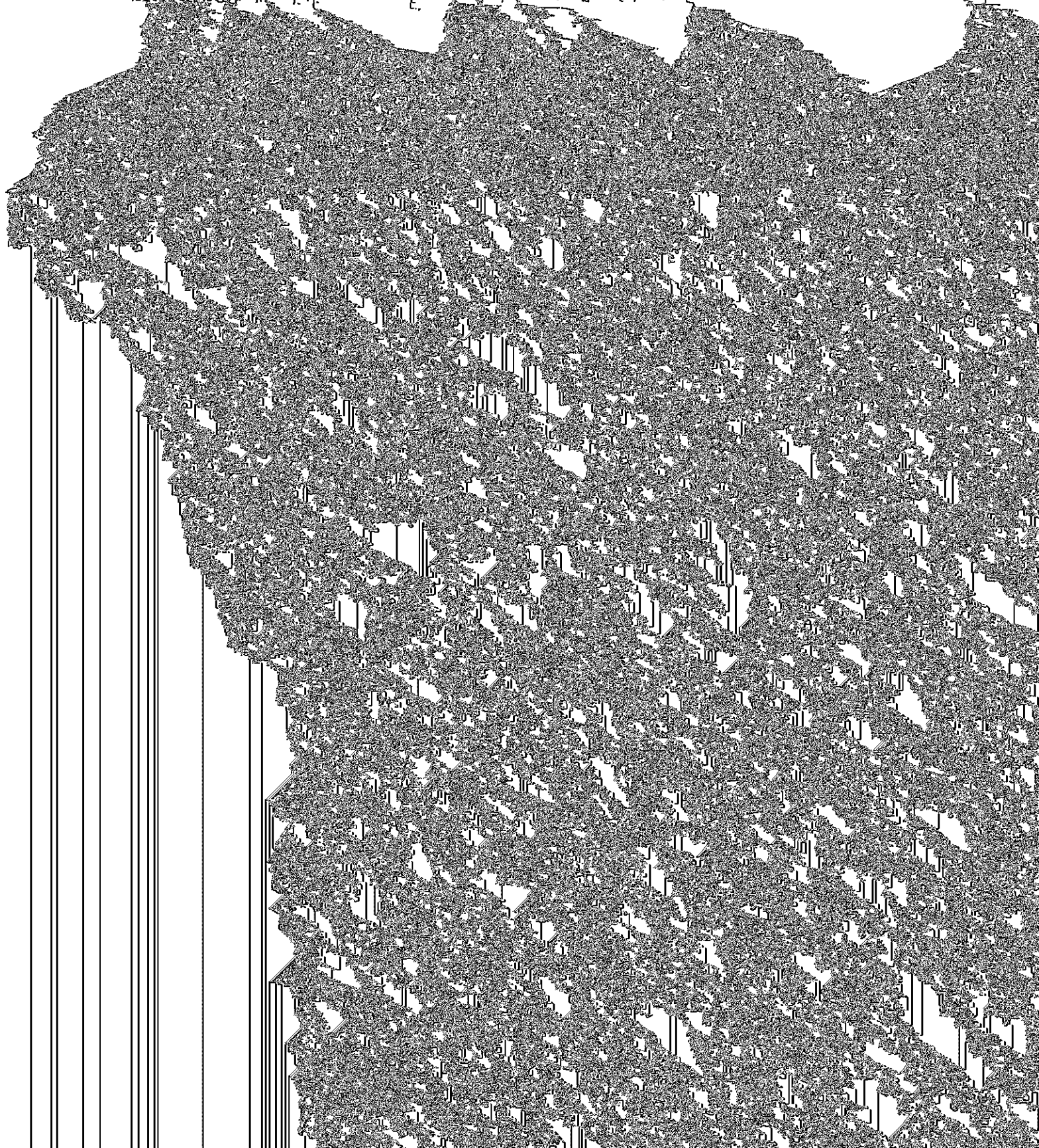

ECSE 3530 – Literacy Assessment and Intervention Strategies
