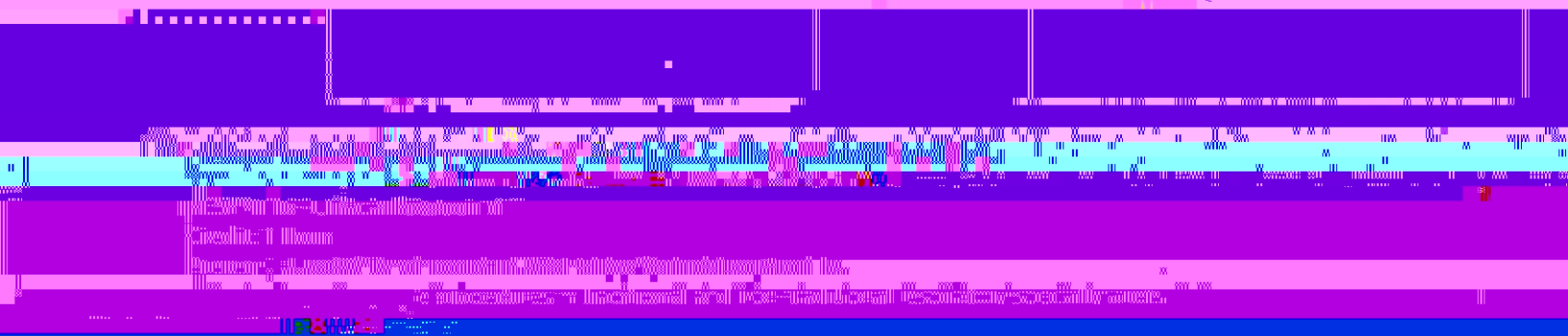

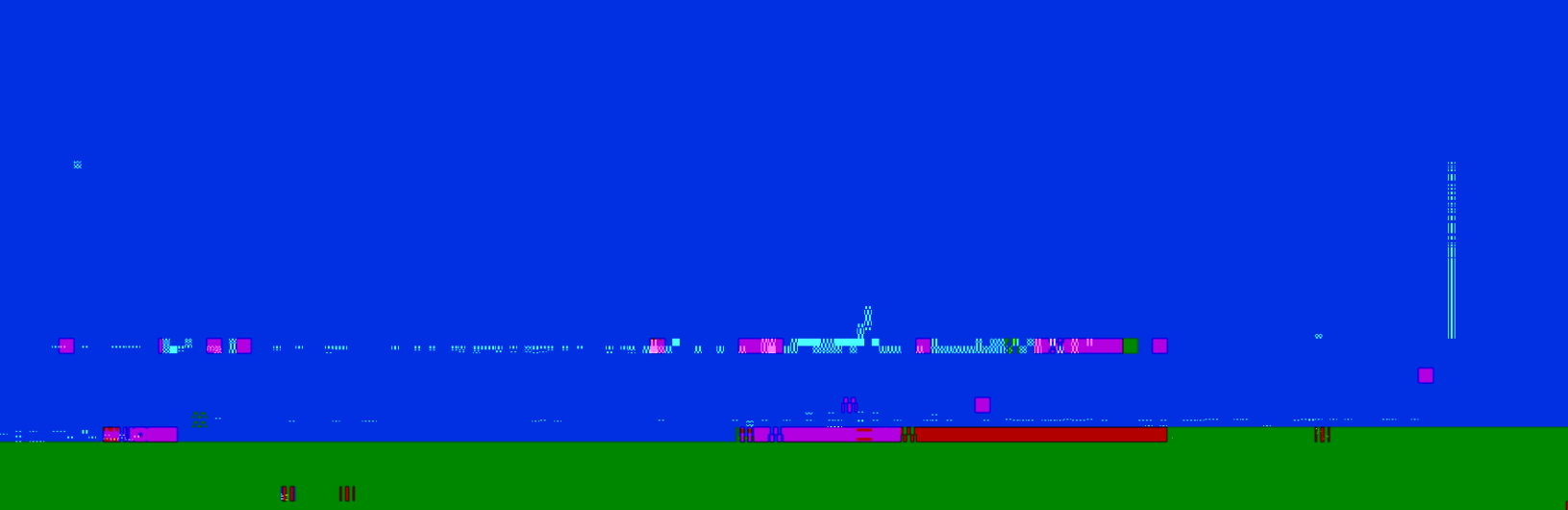


Plot of the function  $f(x,y,z)$

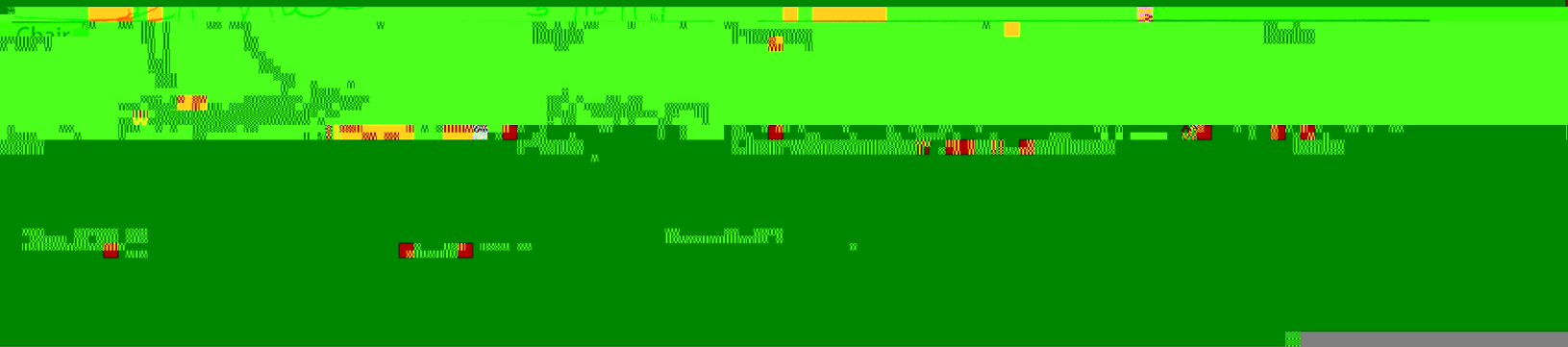

## CLINICAL HOURS

## ATTENDANCE DOCUMENTATION

**DRESS CODE**
