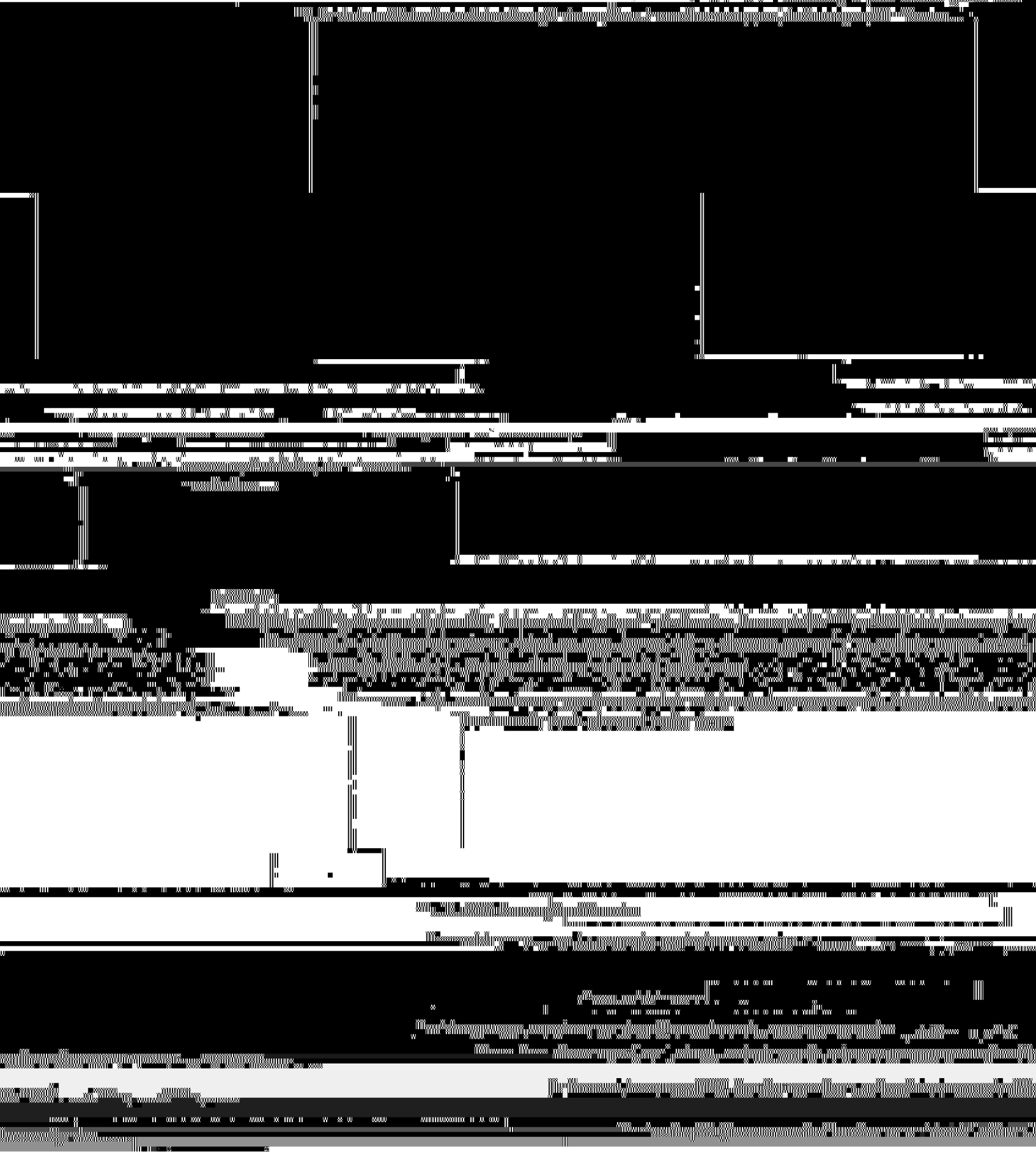


Figure 1: A line graph showing a time series of data points with a clear upward trend and some noise. The x-axis represents time and the y-axis represents a numerical value.
