SOCW 6612 - Advanced Social Work Field Practicum and Integrative Seminar II

Credit: 3 Hours

Prerequisites: Admission to the MSW Program; all foundation level courses; SOCW 6100, SOCW 6300, SOCW 6500, SOCW 6611

Pre/Corequisites: SOCW 6320, SOCW 6400

In this capstone field experience, students will complete 250 hours of field experience and attend a weekly seminar. Under the supervision of an experienced agency field instructor, students will develop, integrate and apply social work theory, knowledge, practice skills, values and ethics with individuals, families, groups, organizations, and communities. Students, agency supervisors

and faculty field instructors plan activities that will support the development of advanced generalist skills as specified in individualized student learning contracts. Students will further develop their ability to assume a variety of social work roles and responsibilities with diverse

populations.

Note: This course includes 250 hours of fieldwork.
