- 4. Old Business:
- a. Updates on committees and collaborations between committees: Members shared updates on committee collaborations. Randy Spaid is checking up with Lorraine Dubuisson and Mary Wolfe and previous APPC chairs about the status of the workload study. Last semester we determined that this study may be useful to the Provost in his broader re-examination of tenure and promotion requirements.
- b. Update on the post-tenure review process: Of the six applicants for PTR, five have set a meeting date and have received the forms. Karmen Lenz has sent an inquiry to a committee member for the other applicant.
- c. Update to Handbook regarding promotion and/or tenure portfolios: Randy Spaid stated that at Friday's Faculty Senate meeting, Lorraine Dubuisson's motion from the Academic Personnel Policies Committee to modify the faculty handbook regarding P & T letters from Assistant Chairs *only by request* was carried by hand vote 18-0.
