7. Discussion of Committee functions and membership document drafted by the Div Inclusion, and Equity Ad Hoc committee in November 2016.

A member requested clarification for how the Diversity Council started. Answer: The committee was a mandate from the president; the committee drafted a Diversity state university that was then modified and adopted by the President's cabinet. The ad how also recommended the formation of a Diversity Council.

The Council then looked at the document outlining the membership and functions of Diversity Council that was drafted by the ad hoc committee:

- Membership: the Council noted that we still need a student representative
- Budget: The uncertainty of having a budget was discussed extensively. The Cou
 discussed the need to define a line of programs and events in order to put a budg
 The Council also discussed possible sources of funding, such as the Foundation.
 also talked about the events that already exist and that are related to promoting c
 awareness such as the International Food Festival (Cochran), a roundtable of fac
 various countries sharing their experiences (Cochran), a cultural festival (Macon

- council suggested a speaker series, and noted that since a committee is already in place to bring speakers to campus, this could be a recommendation made to this committee.
- Advise and assist: the question was raised whether this is the purview of this Council or whether these are HR matters. Dr. Wengier that the ad hoc committee thought of this function as mirroring the 'green zone' points of contact for military and veterans, but for issues of diversity. Dr. Spangler suggested the creation of "Knights Understand Diversity Representatives."
- Awards: The Council noted that there is already a Faculty Recognition committee. The Council suggested that it draft a document with a rubric regarding diversity-related awards and recommend the addition of such awards to the Faculty Recognition committee.
- Report: The issue was raised that such a report should be done at the institutional level rather than at the council level.
- Calendar: The feasibility and the logistics of the calendar were discussed.

The council decided to table the document as the issues it raises require further reflection. First – Lopez. Second – Wang. Tabled.
