## **MEMORANDUM**

The Office of Academic Affairs recognizes that transparency and continuous improvement require intentionality. This memo includes notifications to the Academic Affairs Committee of issues with a common thread of documenting information that is accurate and aligned with University System of Georgia (USG) and Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) guidelines. Supporting documents are attached as appropriate.

There is a proposed change to Academic Renewal Policy

In accordance with the USG Board of Regency Policy 3.5.3 Academic Renewal, undergraduate students who are either returning to a USG institution or are transferring to a USG institution may be eligible for Academic Renewal. Academic Renewal for the students where the students are the students are transferring to a student must be

absent <u>3 years</u> (not term driven) from a regionally accredited institution. Academic Renewal is granted only <u>one</u> time.

The proposal is to remove the segment in yellow and add "a first academic degree".
