The purpose of this hearing is to determine if the student has violated the Student Code of Conduct starting from the previous 2023.

The Student Code of Conduct is a set of rules that governs the behavior of students at Middle Georgia State University. It is designed to create a safe and respectful learning environment for all students.

The Student Code of Conduct is divided into several sections, including:

• **General Provisions**

• **Academic Integrity**

- **Sexual Harassment and Sexual Assault**
- **Stalking**
- **Harassment**
- **Discrimination**
- **Substance Use**
- **Alcohol Use**
- **Drugs**
- **Weapons**
- **Firearms**
- **Explosives**
- **Other Prohibited Activities**

The Student Code of Conduct is enforced by the Student Conduct Board. The Board is composed of students and faculty members who are trained to hear cases and impose sanctions.

Students who are accused of violating the Student Code of Conduct will receive a notice of charges and have the opportunity to be heard by the Student Conduct Board. The Board will determine if the student is responsible for the alleged violation and impose appropriate sanctions.

Sanctions may include:

• **Warning**

• **Probation**

• **Expulsion**

• **Restitution**

• **Community Service**

• **Other**
