 - Neil Rigole proposed Computer Science Associate and Bachelor programs
Computer Science is geared toward programming and back-ending, and many em anInteraction and Education.

Both programs carried unanimously in favor

- David Biek proposed Master of Education in Curriculum and Instruction with a Focus on Literacy program
Unique Master of Education (doesn't focus on leadership, rather the "nuts and bolts" of education itself). Literacy is one of the levers that drives student achievement. 10 courses, 30 credit hours, fully online, non-cohort base. Getting a Master's Degree is the most reliable way to get a permanent raise.
This new Master's Program does not represent a substantive change for SACS
Program carried unanimously in favor
- Rhonda Amerson proposed Minor in Education
There is a shortage of teachers leads us to turn to students currently pursuing a degree to become waiver teachers
15 hours, 5 classes (none require practicum)
Minor carried unanimously in favor
- Rebekah Hazlett-Knudsen proposed Minor in Social Work

We have the Major, but offering the Minor to students who didn't have
