Discussion of proposals for new programs and related courses

- Doctorate in Public Safety David Biek proposed new program with related courses. Professional Doctorate (designed for early, middle, and late career Public Safety professionals). Consistent with MGA's commitment to provide professionally used degree programs, 54 credit hour curriculum (designed to be completely offered online) combining theory, skills, and application; 11 course core curriculum with global or cultural competency component; 2 tracks from which to choose the program is an applied dissertation program; Gerald Lucas (on behalf of the Graduate Studies Council) suggested that SFTY 8420 should be a core requirement rather than as an elective, and that SFTY 7100 and 7110 could be combined into 1 course; in course descriptions, the verbiage will be "Public Safety" rather than "Criminal Justice."
