- 5. After successful account creation, checkrytMGA email for the "Confirmation of Account Creation" email from Platform Management and click the link to verify your email.
 - x If the email doesn't appear in womain inbox, then check your spam/junk folder.
 - x If it does appear in your junk folder, then be sure to click the "it's not spam" link at the top of the email to ensure that future notifications are directed towards your main inbox.
