Middle Georgia State University Foundation, Inc. offers presidential scholarships to graduating high school seniors with high academic promise who are currently accepted for enrollment at Middle Georgia State University. Each of the presidential scholarships are awarded based on criteria specified by the donors; which may include financial need, merit, academic test scores, declared major, or any combination. Presidential scholarships are in the amount of \$5,000 per academic year for a period of four years—resulting in a total scholarship of \$20,000.

Available presidential scholarships for the 2016-2017 academic year are: in the humanities,

including, but not limited to, English history, philosophy and the arts. These scholarships are renewable for a maximum of three consecutive years, provided the recipient maintains a minimum 3.0 GPA and is making satisfactory progress toward graduation. The Foundation's Board of Trustees established this scholarship to honor David A. Bell, Ph.D. for his exemplary leadership of Macon State College (now Middle Georgia State University) from 1997 to 2011, during which period the college experienced the most accelerated growth in its history. This scholarship serves as a lasting tribute to Dr. Bell. ~~He~~ graduated with a minimum 3.5 high

school GPA, and plans to pursue a bachelor's degree at Middle Georgia State University. The scholarship is renewable for a maximum of three consecutive years, provided the recipient maintains a minimum 3.0 GPA and is making satisfactory progress toward graduation. Founded in 1886, the Coca-Cola Company is the world's leading manufacturer, marketer, and distributor of non-alcoholic beverage concentrates and syrups, used to produce nearly 400 beverage brands.
