- o have a 2.50 overall Grade Point Average
- o have a 2.50 nursing core curriculum Grade Point Average.
- o score 4 or above on the TEAS Entrance Exam.
- o have completed Area A, BIOL 2251 and BIOL 2252
- o submit an online application and TEAS score prior to the application deadline
