The five semester long program consists of 18 classes, which require the student to complete 1960 to contact hours of instruction. To complete the contact hours of instruction. The program is "hands on" oriented, with much of the instruction delivered in a hangar environment.

While the ratio can be higher in the dassroom environment, additional instructor supervision must be present in the laboratory to accommodate student numbers greater than 25.

Currently, the AMTP program instruction takes place exclusively on the Eastman campus, largely due to the contact hours requiret the


